October has been a busy month for me. The last week of October, I spent nine days in Elkhart, Indiana, serving on the AMBS board, attending Sara Wenger Shenk's inauguration and being part of an important consultation on distance learning for us in the Pacific Northwest. All the Mennonite colleges were represented, along with both seminaries, to discuss a delivery system for distance learning. In the next few months I hope to share with you a website where you can go to see all the classes being offered online, hybrid, or traditional (on site) by both seminaries. You will be able to see the courses a year in advance. Second, AMBS has started a webinar where you can participate in a short workshop/discussion on various topics they are offering.

The undergraduate schools are exploring combining efforts to offer new degrees and graduate level degrees online. These are exciting first steps to providing more consistent learning opportunities to those of us not located near a Mennonite school. If you have any ideas regarding distance learning please feel free to send them my way.


Indonesia volcano, flooding: More than 100,000 people in Java, Indonesia, have been evacuated from their homes near Mount Merapi, a volcano that has been erupting continuously since Oct. 26. MCC Indonesia and its partner, Indonesian Mennonite Diakonial Service (Indonesian MDS), are planning an emergency response to assist people displaced by the volcano, but details are still being determined. (Indonesian MDS has no connection to Mennonite Disaster Service.)

The volcano also has caused the temporary relocation of two MCC families who live in Yogyakarta to Salatiga, where MCC offices are located. If ash spreads to Salatiga, the staff is prepared to enact further contingency plans.

At the same time, Indonesian MDS, the relief and peacebuilding arm of the Muria Mennonite Synod, continue to respond to the Oct. 4 flash flooding in Wasior, Papua. Although the Wasior disaster has received very little media attention, the need is great. MCC has committed \$20,000 in that response. Anyone wishing to contribute to MCC's response in Indonesia and around the world may give to wherever needed most. <u>mcc.org/waystogive</u>
