#### Mennonite Disaster Service

Landis Homes Retirement Community residents donated over \$39,000 to an **MDS bunk trailer project** which sleeps 18, has three showers, dressing rooms, two restrooms, a utility room and two sinks. The trailer is 51 feet long with 44 feet of livable space. After an April 4th dedication service at Landis Homes, residents wrote messages of hope and encouragement on a bed support that will be used in the bunks. The trailer is headed to West Liberty, KY, where it will be parked at the West Liberty Mennonite Church. It will house MDS volunteers who are there cleaning up and repairing homes damaged by a tornado in early March.
