

LODGING OPTIONS IN KALISPELL, MT

You basically get what you pay for in Kalispell. Facilities range from very basic to very deluxe. There are other motels in the area. The ones listed are closest to our meeting site and are in better locations. There is a 7% bed tax that is not included in these prices. If you call to make reservations, let the hotel know you are part of the Mennonite convention. In some hotels, this may mean a reduction in price, and may make a room available to you when they might otherwise say they are full. In any case, reserve early!

Camping

*The best camping is in **Glacier National Park** which is about 45 minutes from our meeting site. The campgrounds listed below are closer to town, less private and not as scenic. Taxes are not included in the following prices. Please remember that this is a tourist location and if reservations are not made ahead of time, it is doubtful if camping space will be available.*

5121 Highway 93 south Whitefish...about 10 miles north of our meeting site. This is a nice facility but it still closed and unavailable for more information as of this mailing.

www.glaciercamping.com 825 Helena Flats Road. 120 sites. Full hook-up RV's for \$33/night. tenting for \$21/night. By a creek but there is no pool. Removed from highway noise. Big-rig friendly, satellite, shade sites, open sites, showers, wi-fi and cable included. East of our meeting site about 10 miles.

www.glacierpines.com 120 Swan Mountain Drive 75 RV sites. No tenting. For members of Good Sam, AAA and AARP the cost is \$27/night plus tax for first two persons. Others begin at \$30/night. More than 2 persons – extra charge of \$2/person. Heated outdoor pool. \$2/person day use for others.

Spruce Park on the River (406-752-6321)

Operated by our friends, a Christian family, they will give a 10% discount if you let them know you are coming for our conference. Bathhouses and laundry facilities available. Normal prices for RV sites are \$39 /night plus tax, with or without sewer, six tent sites at \$28.50 / night plus tax.

(Each site is for 2 adults and their minor children. Any extras are \$4/day. We require a reservation made with a credit card. We will charge a nonrefundable \$28.50 deposit on the card after March 1. Call or visit our website for more information.)
