<u>Kansas City 2015</u>: Folks from PNMC met yesterday afternoon for a time of prayer at Zion Mennonite Church. Thirty people participated from nine congregations. The meaningful time together included scripture, singing, silence, spoken prayer, and a shared meal.

Earlier this month, more than 50 people from 15 congregations within the PNMC met with Ervin Stutzman, MC USA director, to hear plans for this summer's delegate assembly. If you missed the gathering, you may register for an informational webinar <u>here</u>.

The church is encouraged to use this <u>six week spiritual discernment resource</u> in preparation for the MC USA convention in Kansas City, MO, **June 30 - July 5, 2015**. Significant dialogue and decision-making will be taking place that calls us to seek God's will for the future of the church. We must ask, "*Where is God leading us as a people?*" The primary hope of the resource, designed and illustrated by Leo Hartshorn, is to help individuals listen to and encounter God in daily life. Through spiritual discernment and preparation, there is hope that we can move beyond

simply coming together to press for own perspectives to dominate the church, but to seek the will of God together for the church in all its diversity. This calls for the practices of prayer, surrendering ourselves and our wills, in order to be open to God's leading through the practice of spiritual discernment.

The 2015 Mennonite Church USA Convention in Kansas City, MO, is quickly approaching. There are just three weeks left to register!

Our hearts go out to the family of <u>Joel Kauffmann</u>, who passed away on **Friday, May 8**, after sustaining a head injury. Joel was the spouse of Nancy Kauffmann, a denominational minister of MC USA who has worked closely with PNMC. Joel was born in Hopedale, IL, to Ivan and Lola (Good) Kauffmann in 1950. A Goshen resident since 1970, Joel was well-known for his cartoon strip "**Pontius Puddle**." He was working as content coordinator for the Museum of the Bible in Washington, D.C. He was developer of Israel's Nazareth Village and Menno-Hof in Shipshewana.
