MDS representatives recently visited the Briar Creek Road Baptist Church near Charlotte, NC to assess the needs for support in rebuilding a burned building on the property. During the last week of June several predominantly African-American churches were burned in southern states, charring either their main church building or buildings on their property. Three of the nearly half-dozen burnings were determined as set intentionally. While the fire at Briar Creek Road has been determined as arson, officials have not determined if it was intended as a hate crime.
