# From the PNMC Office

We turn our attention and prayers to our brothers & sisters from Calvary Mennonite and the Roca de Salvación congregations. Over 25 years ago, Zion Mennonite and Calvary Mennonite partnered to reach out to the Hispanic community in the Canby, Aurora, Hubbard, and Woodburn area. From that vision and mission, Iglesia Menonita Roca de Salvación was formed and currently worships with Calvary Mennonite. Due to changes in our current governmental administration concerning immigration, our brothers and sisters are concerned and fearful. Our people are affected by possible changes to DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals), permanent residential status, and border crossings. Both Zion and Calvary have a continued commitment to be sanctuary churches. All three congregations are working towards acquiring proper documentation, especially for those children that were born or brought to the United States.

All are invited to PNMC's 2017 Annual Meeting in Ritzville, WA, June 23-24. The purpose is to build up congregations through workshops that add skills, to enrich our conference through fellowship that creates relationships, and build up our witness to the world through inspiring worship, and challenging one another to greater faithfulness. Our Love Builds Up theme comes from 1 Corinthians 8 in the discussion of meat offered to idols; realizing that eating or not isn't the issue, the spiritual well-being of our brothers and sisters is. The event will be hosted by Menno Mennonite Church, where Lyn and Jeannie Hershey begin as interim pastors on May 15. #### Zion Mennonite Church

"THE UNHEARD VOICE OF THE CHRISTIANS OF THE MIDDLE EAST" will be heard **Sunday, April 9**, at Zion Mennonite Church, in Hubbard, OR, when **Dr. Alex Awad** will preach during the morning worship; share and take questions during Sunday School, during a potluck following the worship service, and again during Zion's Second Sunday hour (5:30-6:30pm). Dr. Awad, a native of Israel/Palestine, is a former Methodist missionary, Professor Emeritus and former President of Bethlehem Bible College in the West Bank. At BBC he has often partnered with Mennonite mission and service workers, and has shared and presented to delegates and attendees at MCUSA's 2015 convention, and more recently to PNMC pastors and leaders. Like most Middle Eastern Christians of various denominations (*Catholic, Orthodox, Protestant and Evangelical*), Dr. Awad is sympathetic to Jewish and Muslim neighbors, friends and family members, and has worked for peace between them. During the Sunday School hour, Dr. Awad will share the Palestinian Christian perspective on Biblical interpretation, including what it says about militant Zionism. During the potluck he will share personal perspectives and stories about peacemaking in the midst of hostility and militancy. The evening session will be more informal and conversational. Dr. Awad brings a fresh voice to an ancient conflict, one resonant with faithfulness to Jesus Christ and Christ's compassion for all.

# Mennonite Healthcare Fellowship

Mennonite Healthcare Fellowship (MHF) encourages students in healthcare professions to learn and serve in cross-cultural/mission settings in developing countries. To further this aim we provide educational grant funding for a Student Elective Term (SET). A SET grant provides travel and living subsidies to enable graduate students in healthcare professional study programs to take a study term in a cross-cultural mission setting in a developing country. MHF also helps with facilitation and coordination of such an experience in cooperation with various Christian agencies. Examples of eligible students in the field of medicine, dentistry, or students in Masters programs for nursing, social work or physical therapy. The term or service must be at least 4 weeks, but 6-8 weeks is preferable. The application deadline for the 2017-2018 academic year is May 15, 2017.

From Oct. 2016-March 2017, Carolyn Heggen and Rhoda Keener led three advanced Sister Care leadership training seminars for 90 women from 20 countries in Central and South America. Many of the participants had been teaching Sister Care to others and these trainings provided a review of the original seminar as well as additional

"going deeper" materials for each of the seminar's four units. Women responded, saying: "You carried us by the hand to these places that we don't often go. In this journey where there is pain we also find hope," and, "We feel transformed and we are going home different than we were when we came. God has used you to give inspiring tools for us." 
