"MCC Service in Vietnam, A Personal Story: From War to Forgiveness" will be presented at the Pacific Northwest Mennonite Historical Society's Annual Meeting and program at Zion Mennonite Church on Saturday, January 19, 2019. Guest speaker and Oregon native, Jessie Gingrich Hostetler from Portland Mennonite will share her experience as an MCC volunteer in Vietnam (1966-68) which included being caught up in the TET offensive, a turning point in the Vietnam War. She will also talk about her ongoing family relationship with that country. For some this war was lived experience, for others it is distant history. Come hear Jessie's inspiring story of God's love and protection and the value of service, particularly during her formative years.
