Eugene Mennonite Church

The EMC ministry Laundry Unicorns has been providing an opportunity for local people living on the street to get their laundry done for free. However, due to the pandemic, EMC is now collecting laundry from camps, both those sanctioned and unsanctioned by local cities. Additionally, congregation members who don't need the stimulus checks are donating their money to a special benevolence fund, which will be used for local families in need. Eugene Mennonite is also supporting local agencies and Lane County by calling service agencies to determine what changes they have made to their services and helping to communicate those changes more broadly. Finally, EMC is increasing their web of communication. Volunteers are making weekly calls to members and friends to see how they are doing, to talk for a bit and to see if they are having their needs met. This has led to some of our congregation making masks or going to the store to buy groceries for others.
