## PNMC ANNUAL MEETING 2021 -

August 21, 2021 9 am -12 pm PDT on Zoom Love will lead us home - Exodus 15:1-2, 11-13

Yes, PNMC is holding our Annual Meeting/Delegate Assembly online again this year, but with a few differences from last year. In 2020, we only conducted delegate business, but this year we also want to:

WORSHIP TOGETHER -- there will be a PNMC virtual choir\* led by Bruce Kuhns (Portland Mennonite), Amy Epp (Seattle Mennonite) will "draw" the scripture, and Peter Epp (Albany Mennonite) will offer a short meditation.

SHARE TOGETHER -- last year we couldn't use breakout groups because Zoom didn't support interpretation on their platform.

Now they do, and we look forward to conversation "around your tables" to get to know one another better.

REFLECT TOGETHER -- it's been a difficult year in so many ways and we want to learn what has been happing in PNMC as a whole and in our congregations, through roll call response, and reporting from staff and board members.

REMEMBER OUR CONNECTIONS -- folks from various Mennonite Agencies will be with us for a round of "speed" information about the resources available to us from the wider church.

LOOK AHEAD TOGETHER -- as delegates vote on the ballot for PNMC leaders you pave the way toward the future. Mennonite Church USA has named "Transformation" as the theme for the next biennium, may we in PNMC embrace that journey as well and be transformed, not just by our changing world, but by the movement of the Spirit among us!
