West Coast MCC — An update from Beth Landis, PNMC appointee to the WCMCC Board

MCC has three focus areas for the next five years. West Coast MCC board met recently and here is what we are doing in our region. Vulnerable, displaced, persons. Border areas – Staff and increasing collaboration with other agencies in southern Arizona.

- Responding to the increased demand for services for application for visas, residencies, individual consultations, legal services in California. Increase peacebuilding and emphasis on justice and peace. Restorative justice programs in Phoenix and California areas, with emphasis on education for teachers and school systems.
- **Creation care** especially related to marginalized peoples affected by climate change. WCMCC does not have specific programs for this goal and so we are challenged to think about the best ways for environmental justice.

In other **updates**, we learned:

- the thrift stores in our region continue to do well and contribute to our mission.
- new office space in Fresno brings convenience, new connections in Fresno, and more presence.

• Youth and engagement of young people are an overlay on all the focus areas. WCMCC has summer programs, SALT – young adults serving abroad, and IVEPers – international young adults in our region. We want to increase young adult participation and incorporate their values and ideals into our programming.

• About MCC relief plans in Ukraine.
