Come, Gather at the Lakeshore!

The 2025 PNMC Annual Meeting will be held June 19-22 at Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp (FLBC) on the shores of Flathead Lake, near Kalispell, MT. We're excited to gather at an all-inclusive site like FLBC because it means our sessions, meals and lodging will all be in one location, and we can really savor the time together in this beautiful place!

We will continue with our overarching theme for 2025, "The Transforming Church." At the February CCC meeting we focused on our historical roots as Anabaptist Christians who are commemorating our 500th anniversary. At the Annual Meeting we will bring our focus to this present moment in our unfolding story, and how we are being transformed as the Body of Christ here and now. Our grounding scripture, Romans 12:2, will guide us in asking, What does it mean to center our life on Christ, on community, and on the way of reconciliation and peacemaking, without being conformed to the patterns of this world? How do we together face into the challenges that are before us? How do we bear witness to the love of God as we care for our congregations, our neighbors and our planetary home?

Registration is open for the 2025 PNMC Annual Meeting in Kalispell, Montana and we are looking forward with glad anticipation to welcoming you all to the gathering. If they haven't already done so, congregations should appoint delegates and encourage their delegates to register for the annual meeting in a timely manner.

Each member congregation is entitled to one delegate for each twenty-five members or fraction thereof.

For example, a congregation with 80 members would be entitled to 4 delegates. In addition to these delegates, all ordained or licensed ministers whose ministerial credentials are recognized by the conference and who are under assignment to a PNMC member congregation are also delegates.

Members of PNMC congregations who are not appointed as delegates are also encouraged to register for the annual meeting. Non-delegates may participate equally in all of the worship services, workshops, keynote addresses and activities. They are also welcome to attend the delegate sessions as non-voting observers, although they may participate in the table group discussions.
